The Procedure to cure heart rhythm disorders is to destroy the abnormal cells in the heart which make abnormal rhythm

Preparation Before Proceeding

Laboratory Preparation

8 hours fasting before proceeding

Discontinuation of some drugs if needed

Steps in Ablation Procedure

- It is undergone in catheterization ward
- Patient is under local or general anesthesia (if needed) on right groin or right neck.
- Then from the place of anesthesia a sheath is inserted, in which in some cases the patient will feel pain.
- After the sheath is attached the cable will be inserted into the heart.
- When performing of ablation the patient can feel pain but the doctor will give painkiller to reduce pain.
- The Procedure takes approximately 3 - 6 hours.
- Patient will be monitored by doctors and nurses after ablation
